

Electrical safety with The Wiggles

Activity sheet for educators



Over just five years, almost 500 Queensland children younger than nine were injured by electricity.

The Wiggles' song, 'Electricity', educates children about the dangers of electricity and what they can do to stay safe.

Step 1.

Ask your class the following questions:

What do you know about electricity?

Examples/prompts:

- Electricity is invisible
- Electricity powers many things in our home and classroom
- Electricity charges your electrical devices and toys

What do you use that needs electricity?

Examples/prompts:

- Tablets
- Phones
- TV
- Lights
- Fans
- Aircons

Step 2.

Play The Wiggles' song 'Electricity'

Step 3.

Ask your class the following questions:

What was your favourite part of the song?

Tell me one thing you learnt about electricity?

Step 4.

Complete The Wiggles colour-in activity or send it home with children.



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
